

Mini sachet application tips

Mini sachet should be placed **INSIDE** the canopy, **AWAY** from direct sunlight.

- Distribute the sachets at various levels of the canopy, including near the top (if possible)
- The sachet side with the barcode and exit hole should face inward, toward the plant. This helps protect the exit hole from splashing water and wind.
- The side with the color label should face out.
- The sachets are water-resistant, but not water-proof.

Tips:

Do NOT modify, 'improve', or open the sachet. The exit hole is perfectly sized.

- Do not place the sachets where they will be exposed to direct sunlight or heating pipes.
- The sachets will heat up release the mites too quickly, reducing the lifespan of the sachet.
- As the plant increases in size the number of sachets may need to increase as well
- When sachets are being directed at existing pest infestations, the sachets can be placed above where you see damage. Confirm with a microscope or hand lens, but often times pests like russet mites are traveling up the plant.



What you should *not* do

1. These cups were placed on the soil surface and not hung from plant. The mites never made it onto the plant.
2. Placing sachets at the base of tall plants exposes them to the drying effects of wind and sun.
3. The sachets are not designed to be opened and broadcast over the plants.
